Bringing in new units will take some time and require approval from the Division of the State Architect (DSA), but we are working as quick as possible to get some cool air flowing through our classrooms.

West Underground Utility Lines, and New Marquee Signs

During the investigation and assessment of the West Underground Utility Lines, it was brought to our attention that the utility lines were in worse condition than expected. Over the 75 years of it's lifetime, sections of the waste line have sunk, resulting in constant back ups and overall inefficiencies of the system. Architects and mechanical engineers are working diligently to figure out the logistics of the most feasible location to place these lines, while keeping the new MPR into consideration.

As for the marquee signs, we are currently in the Pre-Design/Architectural Program Development Phase. In this phase, the consultants will perform pre-design investigation to establish appropriate guidelines and identify design issues relating to functional needs, directive and constraints imposed by applicable regulatory codes. We are on track to have the marquees up by the end of summer!

Lastly, with the recent heavy wind and rain, we are aware of power outages within the surrounding areas. The Facilities and Construction team are reviewing options for the district to provide emergency power furring outages and are working on how to incorporate it into a future project.
