The HCSD Board of Trustees has prioritized several key projects as part of the Measure H initiative, reaffirming the district's commitment to enhancing facilities and ensuring cutting-edge, energy-efficient learning environments. At their November 15th meeting, the Board of Trustees approved projects that include significant upgrades to infrastructure, security, and specialized learning spaces.

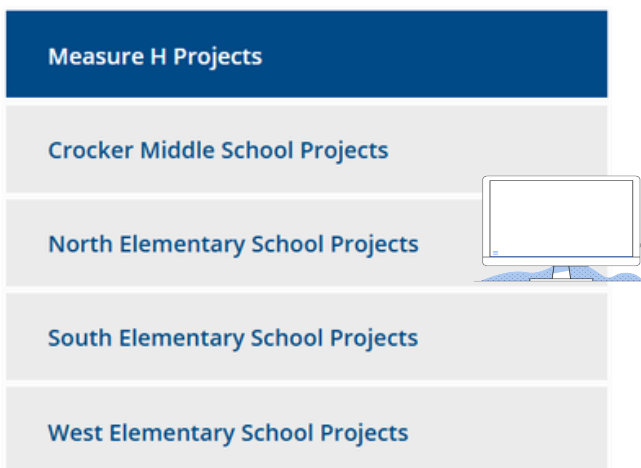

Measure H Projects

The HCSD Facilities Team regularly requests authorization by the Board of Trustees to move forward with projects. This process outlines the project title, scope of work and proposed budget. New Roofing and HVAC Projects in summer 2025: Crocker and South Schools

One major focus in our District is on improving heating and cooling systems at Crocker and South Schools. Plans include using energy-efficient heat pumps for approximately 20-30% of the new HVAC units across all District sites. This initiative balances energy efficiency with our current electrical infrastructure, positioning the district as a leader in sustainable solutions. All new buildings, including the new West MPR and Crocker MPR will utilize heat pump systems which will support environmental sustainability.

Lighting at South School, Security Cameras, Makerspace & Culinary Arts



South A-Pod Lighting

The district selected a contractor to install the new LED lights to illuminate South Elementary School! Contractors were able to work over the Winter Break to get all the new lighting installed and the new lighting looks fantastic! Work ahead for South School includes a new fire alarm system, new roofing, and the installation of new HVAC units!

Security Cameras on All Campuses

Security cameras will be installed on all campuses, including the maintenance yard and the District Office. Installation will begin on the Crocker campus, managed by a contractor familiar with HCSD systems, ensuring smooth integration. The use of security cameras was approved by the HCSD Board of Trustees in the spring of 2024. Parent leaders and staff at each school site will be involved in the recommended locations for the cameras. The Hillsborough Police Department will also work closely with HCSD regarding the placement of cameras on each campus.



Crocker Makerspace and Culinary Arts Classrooms for 2025 and beyond!

With a focus on innovative learning spaces, we are excited to announce upcoming improvements at Crocker Middle School starting in the summer of 2025. These improvements include a new state-of-the-art Multi-purpose Room (MPR), a new Administrative Office, and an upgraded Entrance/ Parking Lot.

As part of this project, the current Lecture Hall will be transformed into a Makerspace, providing students with an inspiring environment for hands-on creativity. Simultaneously, the Culinary Arts Program will be relocated to a reimagined space in the staff workroom, designed in collaboration with Crocker staff and WRNS Studio. These projects reflect HCSD's dedication to fostering dynamic, elective opportunities for students.
