Crocker Community Meeting

On February 3rd, representatives from Quattrocchi Kwok Architects, Van Pelt Construction Services and Blach Construction, joined community members to outline plans for the new Crocker Middle School Multi-purpose Room, new Administration Building and the new School Entrance. Site work on this project will begin as soon as school is dismissed in June 2025!



Security Cameras on All Campuses

Security cameras will be installed on all campuses, including the maintenance yard and the District Office. Installation will begin on the Crocker campus, managed by a contractor familiar with HCSD systems, ensuring smooth integration. Camera installation should be completed in the coming months for Crocker and the District Office and late spring for West, South and North Schools.

New Roofing and HVAC Projects in Summer

2025: Crocker and South Schools

One major focus in our District is on improving heating and cooling systems at Crocker and South Schools. Plans include using energy-efficient heat pumps for approximately 20-30% of the new HVAC units across all District sites. This initiative balances energy efficiency with our current electrical infrastructure, positioning the district as a leader in sustainable solutions. All new buildings, including the new West MPR and Crocker MPR will utilize heat pump systems which will support environmental sustainability.
