### West School Construction Updates

#### Construction is Underway!

Exciting developments are underway at West Elementary School, where the construction of the new Multi-Purpose Room (MPR) is currently in progress.

Contractors have been diligently working on completing underground utility tie-ins and grading the site. In construction, grading involves shaping and leveling the ground to create a stable, even surface for the building while ensuring proper drainage throughout the area.

With the groundwork nearing completion, contractors are now outlining the building footings, which will serve as the foundation for the new MPR structure, as illustrated in the photo below.

The District eagerly anticipates continued advancements on this significant project, which will provide students and staff with a modern, functional space for assemblies, performances, and community events.

## Crocker Middle School Projects

Culinary Arts & Waterline Relocation




#### **Culinary Arts Project at Crocker:**

This project consisted of the transformation of the previous staff work room into the New Culinary Arts Space! Phase I is now complete! Contractors worked on removing previously fixed items such as cabinets, work stations, and flooring. They added new drywall and paint, providing a new brighter Culinary Arts Space. Installation of new electrical outlets, new sinks with hot water, new refrigerator and new furnishings brought the Culinary Arts space to life!

Phase II will commence in Summer 2026, which includes adding storage, relocating the sink and providing new casework, floor installation, and adding additional furnishings to complete the dining room.

#### Town of Hillsborough Waterline Relocation:

Contractors worked throughout the summer to quickly relocate a waterline that went through the Crocker campus that fed water to the Town of Hillsborough. All trenches that were made have been backfilled. Now the new waterline has been relocated and is actively working! It's been a pleasure working closely with the Town of Hillsborough on this project!
